Staff Responsibilities

Staff must ensure they do not reproduce or use copyrighted materials unlawfully. All content used within the setting must comply with copyright legislation and nursery expectations.

Content shared on the nursery website or social media platforms remains the property of Happylands Nursery. Unauthorised sharing or reuse is not permitted.

Monitoring and breaches

Any misuse of nursery content may be addressed in line with nursery policies. Serious breaches may lead to further action.
